Junior Chuck Lay, and leading rebounder was Senior Co-Captain Lon C. Cooper, with Co-Captain Dave Mumby being our play-maker.

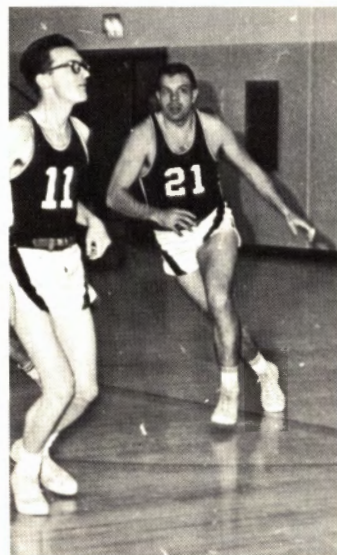
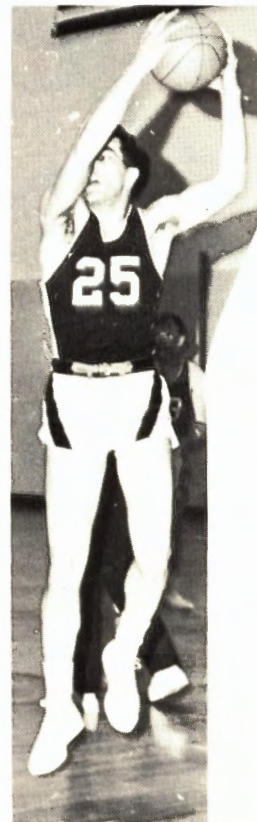
